Minutes of 2022 Fall Meeting  
Virtual  
December 7th, 2022

Cody McCaw, President of SWAF, opened the meeting at 9:00 am. He introduced the current SWAF officers and displayed the anti-trust notice. The previous meeting's minutes were approved after a movement, second, and vote of the membership present.

David Reyes, SWAF Treasurer, shared the Treasurer's report. Revenues consisted of meeting fees in the amount of \$2,201. After expenditures of \$16 for the Spring 2022 meeting and \$3,000 for Scholarships, the ending balance was \$4,949 as of 11/30/2022.

The motion was made to contribute \$1,500 to each of the University of Texas at Austin and Texas Christian University actuarial programs and another \$1,000 to Texas A&M University. The motion was seconded and approved by a vote of the membership present.

New students were introduced. The induction of new students was moved, seconded and approved by a vote of the membership present.

Elections were held for new officers. David Reyes was elected Vice President. Tri Nguyen was elected Secretary/Treasurer. John Stark was elected College Relations Officer. Noah Daniels was elected Education Officer. Ray Rabel will replace Cody McCaw as President.

There was no new business.
