Minutes of 2019 Spring Meeting

June 5, 2020

Robert Zolla, President of SWAF, opened the meeting at 9:00 am. Courtney Rohde explained the Zoom interface to the attendees prior to the business session. For the business session, Robert introduced the current SWAF officers and displayed the anti-trust notice.
